Dear All, Happy new year!

Gates and padlocks.

The Amber Grove padlock was sabotaged last weekend. We found that the code had been changed which can only be done by someone who knows the original code. We had to cut the old lock off and replaced it with a new one costing us £45. If we find that the person responsible is a plot-holder we will treat this vandalism very seriously and they could face being evicted from their plot and the Association immediately. This will also apply to any future similar acts.

In the meantime we have changed the code to 20120 for Amber Grove.

We will also be CHANGING THE CODE FOR ALL THE OTHER PADLOCKS to 20120 over the next week or so. PLEASE DO NOT GIVE THE CODE TO ANYONE WHO IS NOT A PLOT-HOLDER. CAN YOU ALSO REMEMBER TO SCRAMBLE THE NUMBERS ON THE PADLOCK WHEN YOU COME AND GO AND ALWAYS CLOSE AND LOCK THE GATE BEHIND YOU. WE ARE REPEATEDLY FINDING THE PADLOCKS WITH ONE NUMBER CHANGED AND THIS DOES NOT HELP THE SECURITY OF OUR SITE!

Chippings

You may be aware of the very large heap of chippings in the main car park. This is a result of a plot-holder (we would like to know who?) giving the code to a tree surgeon company and inviting them to leave chippings. We have contacted the company, which we identified from the new CCTV cameras and told them not to bring anymore and warned them that we might ask them to come and take it away as it is now taking up virtually half the main car park! We have also asked them for the name of the plot-holder who gave them the gate code.
